IMPORTANT: You must **REGISTER** for a date with the Office at 416-898-3573 or by using the online registration form. We do not accept walk in's/show ups as our space is very limited.

Your tour operator for this trip will be 'Upward Bound'. **Before you leave home be sure to call the Flight Information Weather Update Line at 1-519-221-2359 either the morning of your SUNRISE flight or after 12:00pm for your SUNSET flight** to check that your flight is still on and weather conditions are safe for flying. When you call you will also be advised of the meeting time that you should aim to be at the departure location as set out below.

Should your flight be cancelled call Dave the pilot directly to reschedule at 519-651-2859 or at 1-800-567-2812

Items to Bring

- Camera, extra film and binoculars
- Extra money for in-town dining
- Extra sweater and/or windproof jacket
- Daypack
- Sunscreen and sunglasses
- Bottle of water

Clothes to Wear

Please be sure to dress for the weather as if going for a long walk/hike. Wear comfortable clothing and dress in layers. Running shoes, hiking shoes or comfortable flat sole shoes are highly recommended as you will be standing throughout your flight for over an hour. For the warmer months we don't recommend you wear skirts or high heels as you will be uncomfortable. You may also want to bring an extra sweater just in case you get chilly especially as the early morning and evening temperatures tend to drop in the Country. We strongly suggest bringing a camera and extra batteries (you'll need it!).

In Town

There are many great restaurants in Elora on the main strip including a vegan restaurant called Desert Rose. If you plan on having breakfast/lunch after your flight in the town of Elora just park downtown and walk the charming streets there are plenty of bars/pubs/restaurants to accommodate any taste bud. There is also wonderful easy-moderate level hiking trails as well as tubing down the Elora river (which is a lot of fun if you like water sports). Meeting Spot Map and Location

Elora is located approximately 1.5 hours west from Toronto and is easily accessible by taking HWY 401 West towards HWY 6 north through Guelph, which then turns into HWY 7 straight to the town of Elora. If you are heading from Western Ontario take HWY 401 East towards Guelph Hwy 6 and follow the below Step by Step Driving Directions.

Our Meeting Spot:

The meeting spot will be at Grand River Raceway (racetrack and slots) 7445 Wellington County Rd. 21 in Elora. Please meet Dave at the EAST end of the parking lot (far left hand side). If you think you're lost call the Flight Line 519-221-2359 and leave a message for Emergency direction, Dave WILL call back.

Step by Step Driving Instructions

- Depart HWY 401 and take Hwy 6 NORTH
- Follow HWY 6 North through Guelph (just follow the HWY 6 North signs)
- Turn LEFT (West) onto Elora Rd (approx. 4 Km north of Guelph) which is Wellington RD. 7. On the corner you will see a John Deere tractor sign.
- Continue North-West on Elora Rd keep following this road straight until you reach a the outskirts of Elora. On your right side you'll pass Tim Hortons and shortly after that you will see the Grand River Raceway on your left just before the set of lights.
- Park and meet Dave, your pilot at the end at the East/far left side of the Parking Lot at 7445 Wellington County Rd. 21- Grand River Raceway
