IMPORTANT: You must REGISTER for a date with the Office at 416-898-3573 or by using the online registration form. A deposit is required to hold your spot. We do not accept walk in's/show ups as our space is limited.

Your tour operator for this trip will be 'High Perspective'. Please try to arrive about 5-10 minutes prior to the start of your flight so that they can prepare you guys and do all the office admin before your flights.

Before leaving home, please be sure to call the flight office at 905-294-2536 to check that weather conditions are safe for flying and that you are ok to drive up to Pickering, as we wouldn't want you driving all that way only to find out that your flight has been cancelled due to weather, so please be sure to call ahead.

What to wear:

We ask that you come dressed for the weather and as if you were going on a long walk or hike. For your footwear, wear hiking or running shoes. No open sandals/heels will be permitted, mainly so that they don't fall off and hit someone in the head! Also, be sure to bring at least 1 bottle of water for yourselves, hat, bug spray and sun glasses for eye protection. During the warmer months you can also fly barefoot, the choice is yours! For cooler months we recommend that you bring gloves to keep your hands warm.

Please dress for the weather, for your actual flight dress a little heavier than you would as if going for a walk/hike as temperatures fall the higher you fly. We guarantee a minimum of 1000 feet height up to 2000 feet, however the length of your flight will depend on the number of thermals present in the air the day of your trip, however your flight instructor will do what ever possible to make your flight enjoyable.

*****IMPORTANT!!** BEFORE LEAVING YOUR HOME or STARTING POINT YOU HAVE TO CALL HIGH PERSPECTIVE TO MAKE SURE YOUR FLIGHT IS STILL ON & WIND/WEATHER CONDITIONS ARE SAFE FOR FLYING
CALL 1-800-359-9979 or 905-294-2536. Should the weather cause your trip to be cancelled you can reschedule your flight directly with the High Perspective Office as well.***

Directions to the Pickering Site:

Merge onto HWY 401 from any of the major highways, head **EAST on HWY 401** if coming from downtown or Western Ontario OR head **WEST** if coming from Ajax/Eastern Ontario. Head north on **Brock ROAD** Pickering. **Go past** the 407 to the next intersection and turn left on to **Highway 7 (West)**. We are located about 2km on the right hand side (north side). The street address is 1150 Highway 7. You will see a sign for High Perspective and lots of hang gliders on a field (not to mention a big barn).

If you don't mind a bit of expense, the **407** currently ends at Brock road Pickering. You can take it all the way to Brock Road and then head north to the first set of traffic lights which is highway 7 west. A quicker and slightly cheaper way is to exit the 407 on York Durham Townline 30 and head north to highway 7 at which you will turn right and take highway 7 until you get to our field. The 407 is faster and highly recommended when traveling in rush hour traffic.

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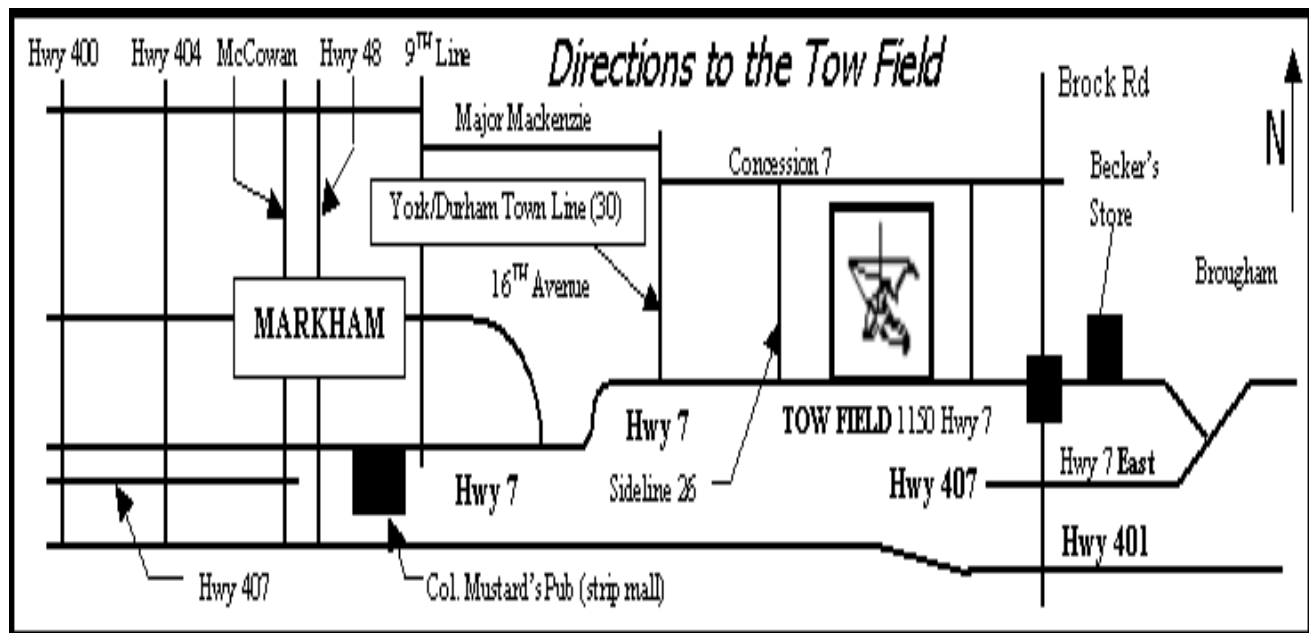
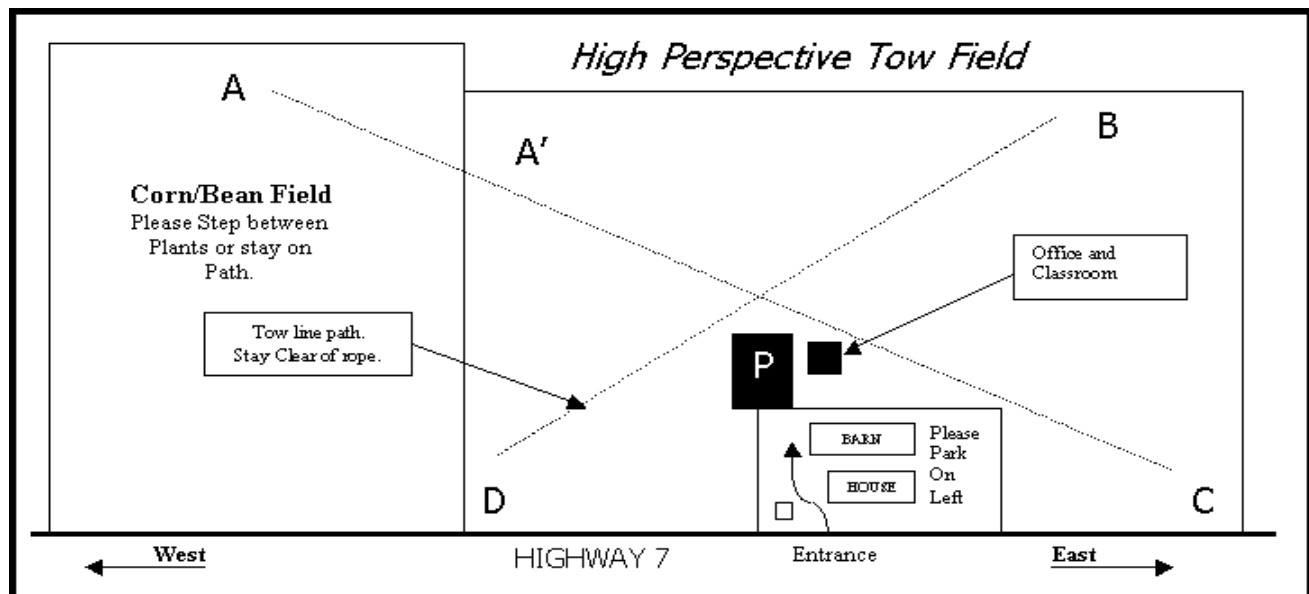
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When you drive in, **drive past the house** and follow the driveway around the barn and you will come to the High Perspective office and clubrooms. Make yourself known to a staff member and they will take care of you.

Parking Instructions

The Tow Field is located at 1150 Hwy 7 two kilometers west of Brock Road. It is the first farm west of sideline 22 or east of 24. When you arrive, please park in the designated area beside the office/clubhouse and make yourself known to a staff member. We will get you prepared for your flight. Depending on the wind direction, launch will be from one of the corners marked A thru to D.

***** Please be very careful when walking across any part of the Tow Field. The line used to tow the gliders is razor sharp and could be on the ground along one of the dotted lines or anywhere in the air. You really want to KEEP WELL CLEAR of the tow line!**

Directions to the Muskoka Flying Sites (July/August ONLY):

CLEVELANDS HOUSE: It's in Minet. Take 169 west from 11 or east from 400 to 118 north (toward Port Carling) to Peninsula Rd., turn and go past Port Sandfield swing bridge to Minet. Turn right at store/gas station which leads to "Cleve's" resort. Park and go down to the main dock.

BALA: Take 169 to Windsor Park in Bala. It's just east of the Bala Bay Hotel or just west of the Beer Store. The dock is on the water but cannot be seen from the road. Park in the lot or on the road side.

TABOO RESORT: Follow the signs from Gravenhurst off Hwy 11. It's a few km north of town on the old road to Bracebridge. Park at the entrance and go to the waterfront.
